WHO WE ARE AND WHAT THIS AGREEMENT DOES

The University will send the Training to you at the email address that you provide when you download the Leaflet. You agree to complete the Training as soon as reasonably possible following receipt of the Training. Your continued use of the Licenced Materials is conditional on your completion of the Training.

WE ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR USE OF THE LICENCED MATERIALS

- Neither the University nor its licensors give any warranty in relation to the Licenced Materials or the uses to which it may be put by you or its fitness or suitability for any particular purpose or under any special conditions, notwithstanding that

The University may cancel your rights to use the Licenced Materials by contacting you if:
